Application Procedure

To apply, complete the Application, the Parent/Guardian Agreement and Participant Agreement with required signatures and dates.

Teens Like Me (TLM) reserves the right to refuse and/or rescind acceptance of a student at TLM sole discretion who we believe is unsuitable for our programs or who subjects the program to any risk of harm or disrespect. Failure to disclose fully any information regarding the participant that results in an inappropriate placement in a TLM position is cause for dismissal.

Program Alterations

It is TLM intention to conduct programs at sites described/selected. Sites may be altered due to any act of God, including weather or other condition affecting the safety of participants, cultural sensitivities, and circumstances beyond TLM control. When possible, families will be notified in advance of such changes. In all cases we will substitute in good faith with something comparable. If a program is cancelled by TLM for any reason prior to its starting date, TLM will place the applicant on another program of his/her choice depending on space availability

Terms of Participation - Conduct

Program policies are established with safety, health and welfare, Common sense and local laws in mind. Chronic defiance of rules and procedures set forth, disrespectful, abusive, unsafe or illegal conduct and profanity will not be tolerated.

We reserve the right to remove participants from the program who TLM ascertains have violated the conditions for participation or whose behaviors are counterproductive to community-building, offensive to or disrespectful of our host community or otherwise detrimental to maintaining standards or successful operation of the program.

Community Service Credits

All participants who complete a TLM program successfully receive a **Certificate of Service** recognizing the hours served, for the 5-8 week programs respectively, and detailing the projects accomplished.

Expectations of TLM Participants

Safe, considerate conduct and respect for the program policies and framework are essential. A mindset of team work and a cooperative attitude are musts. We expect participants to commit to work goals, be actively curious about the community and culture and to come ready to invest in their experience. We live and work in the public eye. Appropriate behavior, language, and dress are necessary.

Participants should be prepared to be flexible and to push their comfort zones for the benefit of gaining an experience in social service.
